4. Application Form, to be typed on A-4 size paper, should be filled in **English Capital (Block) letters using Black or Blue ink only.**

5. Any cutting or overwriting in any part of the application form will render it liable to be rejected. Candidates are, therefore, advised to take special care while filling the application form. **Do not leave any column blank. Incomplete / unsigned and application without requisite copies of certificates will be rejected.**

6. Persons, who are already in Government Service, should submit their applications through respective office and should enclose "No Objection Certificate" obtained from the Competent Authority. Applications received directly are liable to be rejected.

7. Candidates may note that the job of a Deputy Field Officer (GD) also involves field postings at arduous locations **with All India Transfer liability.** Medical standard of the candidates would be as per the Central Government guidelines applicable to Group 'B' posts.

8. **Eligible candidates applying for this post must submit self attested copies of certificates in respect of age, educational qualification and age-relaxation issued by the Competent Authority alongwith the application form published herewith.**

9. The envelope containing application (alongwith requisite copies of certificates and two self-attested recent passport size colour photographs with name & DOB on the back) should be clearly superscribed as "**APPLICATION FOR THE POST OF DEPUTY FIELD OFFICER (GD)**" and sent through **ORDINARY POST** addressed to **Post Bag No. 001, Lodhi Road Head Post Office, New Delhi-110003.**

FORMAT FOR SC/ ST CERTIFICATE

A candidate who claims to belong to one of the Scheduled Caste or the Scheduled Tribes should submit in support of his/ her claim an attested/certified copy of a certificate in the form given below, from the District Officer or the sub-Divisional Officer or any other officer as indicated below of the District in which his parents (or surviving parent) ordinarily reside who has been designated by the State Government concerned as competent to issue such a certificate. If both his parents are dead, the officer signing the certificate should be of the district in which the candidate himself ordinarily resides otherwise than for the purpose of his own education. Wherever photograph is an integral part of the certificate, the Commission would accept only attested photocopies of such certificates and not any other attested or true copy.
